Built in 1906, this historic trolley barn sits in the State park known as Blackmarsh. DNR's dedication to preservation of landmarks such as these, provide us with an opportunity to be part of the preservation efforts of Maryland historic sites.

Repairs to damaged areas were to be done, especially since this structure was damaged by Hurricane Isabel that ravaged many areas in the Maryland region.
